

Local EMS personnel and commissioners discussed various options to help the County Emergency Medical Services prepare for the future. The county is responsible for providing an ambulance service. There was discussion of an EMS Levy, a hybrid county EMS System or a county run agency. In any instance, the first line of business is to form an advisory board and with that:
